^{*}MATH 199E is a 1-credit gateway co-requisite designed to assist students who want to start calculus but need to review fundamental mathematics to be successful in MATH 205 or MATH 231. Grades are completely determined by the number of semester weeks that pass before the student successfully completes all of the exams. Once the exams are passed the student is no longer required to attend on Friday evenings. Students whose schedules prevent them from attending Friday sessions need to register for MATH 155.
