## It's Elementary:

After students have been introduced to the **LEGO Base Set Parts** (Parts are also called elements) use this activity to check of understanding.

## DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Count the number of teams in room (use that many matching puzzles cards)
- 2. Hand out a puzzle card to everyone in the room
- 3. Participants will find puzzle card partner to make a team
- 4. Each puzzle team will need 1 LEGO Base Set
- 5. Puzzle team partners will find together, all parts listed on both puzzle cards
- 6. Place LEGO parts on lid of Base Set in the order found on the puzzle cards
- 7. When puzzle teams finish, they raise a hand to signal completion
- 8. Instructor will check for completion
- 9. Team partners will verbally name all found parts.

## Good Job!

- 10. Instructor picks up the puzzle cards
- 11. Partners place all LEGO parts back in correct location.
- 12. This continues until all teams are finished and all cards are collected
- 13. If time a small reflection is good after this activity.

\*It is a good icebreaker, vocabulary practice, short team activity...
This is just 1 way to use the puzzle pieces.
