The following advice was given by those students who got an “A” or a “B” on the first exam. I have not modified these comments in any way.

- Do homework as soon after class as possible. Make sure you know how to do at least one example for each type of problem in a section.
- I find it helpful to complete or attempt to complete the homework the night it is assigned. Then if I have problems I can always ask for help before it gets to be too much to handle.
- Start studying far in advance - do the work for the day that day and read the lessons before and after class. Also make study sheets of important theorems and proofs.
- Lock yourself in a room for countless hours and do nothing but math. Take notes on every section and make sure you know how to do problems from every section. Going to the math lab is always helpful because Mr. Cunningham is awesome.
- Always do the homework... no matter if you can't get to it the night it is assigned, don't get behind. Then before the test, review all the sections and do some of the problems as practice. Read the sections!
- Make sure to study by reworking problems and not just looking over what you've already done!
- Do your homework at least by the end of the week, if not everyday. But never go more than that without doing it.
- Read the chapters and DO THE HOMEWORK! over and over as practice, this is essential.
